Instructions for Abstract Submission

Preparing and submitting the Abstract

Please prepare your abstract on a word processor and submit it as an email attachment to aaaplus@utoronto.ca

Do not submit your abstract in the body of the email since Greek letters, subscripts, superscripts, and some mathematical symbols will be lost or translated incorrectly. Please specify the word processing package used. The preferred format is a Microsoft Word document file (.doc or .docx).

All abstracts are to be submitted **as soon as possible**. Please put "AAA Abstract" in the subject line of your email. Late abstracts may not be included in the abstract book.

Please use the following formatting for abstract preparation:

- Submit one single-spaced page with 1 inch margins on the top, bottom, right, and left. The whole page should be left and right justified.
- The title of the abstract should be in bold letters 12pt Arial.
- List authors under the title. Underline presenting author. Use 12pt Arial.
- List authors' affiliation under the authors' names. Use 10pt Arial.
- Leave one line space between the affiliations and the text.
- The text of the abstract should be in 12pt Arial.
- Save file as **Lastname_Firstname_Abstract (e.g. Smith_Joe_Abstract)**

Example:

Carcinogenicity of 1-methyl-6-phenylimidazol pyridine and its relation to DNA adduct formation.
