## Re-Application for Residence 2010-2011

**To: All SMC Residents**

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Dear Residents,

As our office prepares for the 2010-2011 admissions cycle, we would like to give all of our current students the chance to reapply to return to residence again next year. Please note that re-admission is not automatic and decisions are based on a number of criteria including:

- Academic status and GPA;
- Dons' evaluations;
- Contribution to one's house, the college, university and/or external community.

To re-apply for residence, simply fill out the attached application and submit it, along with a \$600 reservation deposit, to the Dean's Office by **Monday March 29<sup>th</sup>, 2010.**

All cheques should be made payable to 'USMC'. Cash payments and bank card payments can be made at the SMC Accounting Office which is open from 9:30am – 3:00pm, Monday through Friday. If paying at the Accounting Office, be sure to have them stamp your application form as 'Paid', or bring your payment receipt to the Dean's Office along with your application. Please keep your receipt.

Please do not pay your \$600 deposit to your ROSI account, as all residence deposits must be entered manually by us. Your deposit is fully refundable until the last day of the current residence term (i.e. April 23, 2010). After April 23rd, a partial refund of \$300 will be provided until August 15th. After August 15th, all deposits will be forfeited.

Formal offers of residence will be sent by email once grades are available from UofT (usually late-May/early June). NB: Offers will be sent to the email address you provide on your application form. If your summer contact information changes after submitting your application, please be sure to inform our office directly. Students who still have unpaid residence fees on ROSI must clear their accounts before they are eligible to receive an official offer of residence.

Please note that we reserve the right to cancel the applications of those who fall short of our academic minimums or who receive a negative evaluation from their Don at year's end. In such situations, students will be given a full refund on their reservation deposits.



# SMC Student Residence Returning Resident Application 2010-2011

Residents are expected to be enrolled full-time at the UofT and have a minimum cumulative (and/or annual) GPA of 2.0. Those with GPA's below 2.0 but above 1.49 are eligible to reapply, but may be placed on a lower priority for re-admission depending on demand. Those with GPA's below 1.5 are not considered to be in good academic standing and must submit a letter of appeal to the Dean in order to have their applications considered. Exceptions are typically only made if one's low academic performance was directly related to a health/personal problem which can be verified in writing by a health care professional. Exceptions will only be considered if space permits, after those in good academic standing have been admitted.
