

Dear U of T community member:

As 2020 draws to a close, we'd like to give you a brief update on the Landmark Project.

Like many areas of the University, our team will take a brief pause over the holidays and the construction site will be closed end-of-day December 24. We'll continue drilling up until then – so far, we've completed 36 boreholes at about 818 feet deep. Drilling will resume when the site re-opens on January 4.
