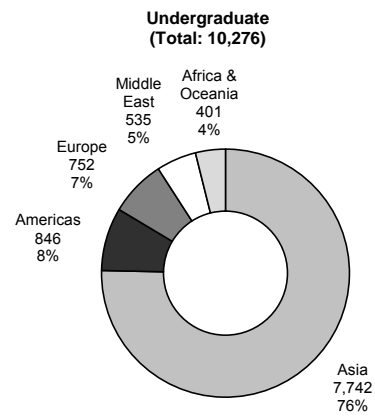

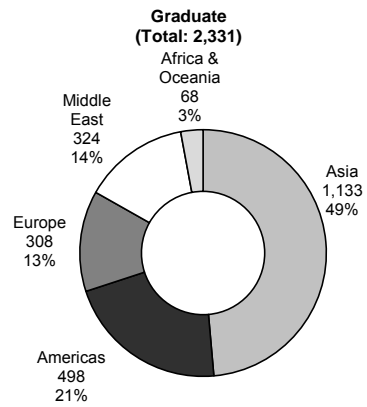
**INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ENROLMENT BY GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN**

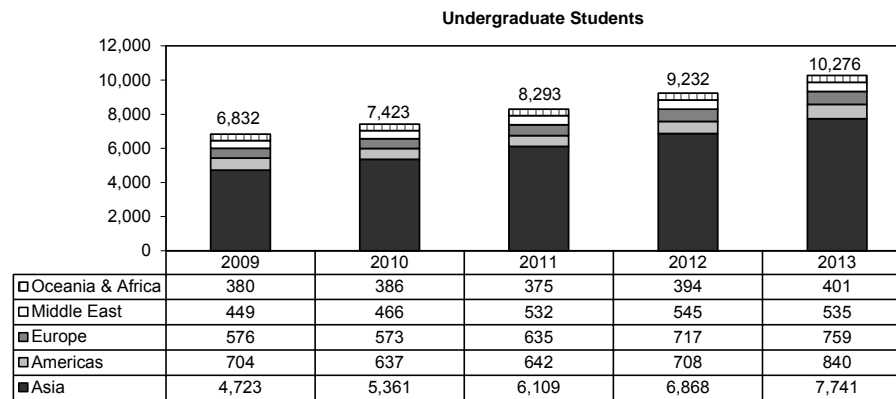

*November 1, 2009 to November 1, 2013*

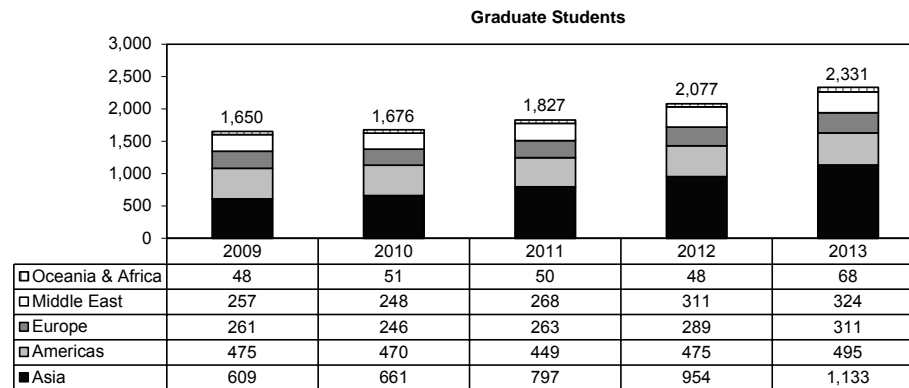

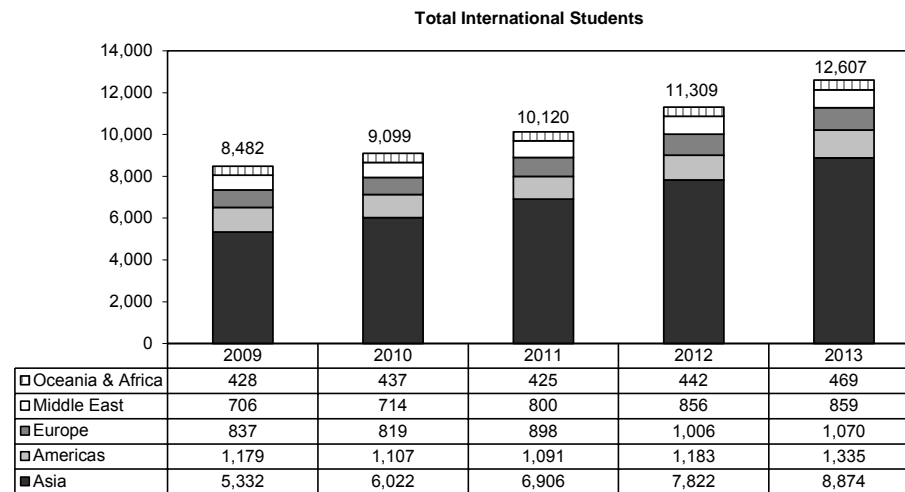
**INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ENROLMENT: FIVE-YEAR TREND (continued)**
